Obituary

Curtis L. Herrod, Sr. was born to George and Jim Ella Herrod in Hollowridge, Mississippi on September 5, 1905. He was the fifth child of 14 children. He moved to Luther, Oklahoma around the age of 8. When Curtis was in the sixth grade, his dad became ill and Curtis left school to help his mother run the farm. Early in life, Curtis accepted Christ as his personal Savior and was faithful until he returned to be with the Lord on April 14, 2006.

Curtis was preceded in death by is mom and dad; sisters Hattie, Callie, Mary, Mattie, Mildred; and brother, Eddo. Curtis said that he had siblings who died as babies. Their names are not known.

Around the age of 20, Curtis moved to Oklahoma City and worked at Wilson Packing Company for 10 years. Curtis then moved to Dallas, Texas where he resided for 50 years. During that time, he worked for Hormel Packing Company for 20 years. While living in Dallas, he married Marie Eloise Christian. To that union Curtis, Jr. was born. Curtis dearly loved and raised Marie’s two daughters, Joyce and Helen. Marie went to be with the Lord in October, 1969.

In April 1990, Curtis met and married Donna Ogles Robinson and joined Bible Baptist Church, Luther, OK. They lived in Luther for 13 years then moved to Oklahoma City. They joined Church on The Rock (COTR), OKC and became active members.

Curtis was faithful to the food ministry at COTR, by assembling food baskets for the hungry. He worked in the bulk mail ministry, distributing thousand of pieces of mail on a regular basis to those associated with the Oklahoma Concert of Prayer.

His favorite hobby was gardening and sharing vegetables with friends and loved ones. But most of all listening to his Bible on Cassette and following along.
